Rules

You and children under your supervision:

- Will comply with any instructions and requests given to you before, during and after the workshop.
- Will not run and will take extra care when around fire.
- Will not cause damage to the workshop area, surrounding areas and attraction.
- Will wear appropriate clothing and footwear whilst participating.
- Will notify the course leader ASAP of any problems that arise or first aid needed during the workshop.
- Decisions made by the course leader are for your safety and are final.

Due to the nature of bush craft workshops, your chosen activity carries some risk.

By signing you are agreeing to the following:

- You acknowledge that taking part in this activity involves some risk and participants accept the activity could be hazardous with cuts, scratches & burns possible. While Godstone Farm and the course leaders take every step to minimise the risks, accidents may happen.
- The workshops include the use of tools, knives, fire and cooking. The use of personal knives is not permitted but you may use knives and tools provided by the course leader.
- Some activities involve working with and/or around live fire, extra care must be taken.
- Participants must wash their hands before and after taking part in a cooking workshop. The closest handwashing stations are located next to the goat bridge by the entrance and by the main toilets.
- When taking part in cooking workshops, participants must inform the course leader of any allergies at the beginning of the workshop. The workshop is stick bread making, the bread is dairy free and gluten free flour will be available on request. The firelighting workshop provides the opportunity to toast marshmallows. Marshmallows are not vegetarian, kosher or halal.
- You confirm the child/children under your care are aged over 4 years and have the ability to take part in the activity.
- You take full responsibility for the child/children you are supervising at all times throughout the activity. Disruptive and unruly behaviour may result in your group being asked to leave the activity, no refunds will be given and the decision of the course leader is final.
- You agree Godstone Farm or the course providers will not take responsibility for loss, damage of clothing or personal belongings or personal injuries sustained including but not limited to scratches, cuts, burns & broken bones.
- You agree to fully waive, release and forever discharge Godstone Farm and Big Hat Bushcamp, its directors, employees and insurers from any and all injuries of any kind, of or to you, your property, or any other person, directly or indirectly arising out of or in connection with your/the child you are taking responsibility for's, participation in the workshop.

- You agree to take no action, or permit anyone on your behalf to take any action against Godstone Farm for injury, losses, damage, claims, demands, lawsuits, expenses and other of any kind, or to you, your property, or any other person, directly or indirectly arising out of or in connection with anyone in your party taking part in the activity.
- You agree any photos taken can be published on the Godstone Farm website and social networking and may be used for advertising purposes by Godstone Farm and/or Big Hat Bushcamp.
