Main Job Tasks and Responsibilities

We aim to ensure all guests receive the best service in all areas of the farm whilst made to feel welcome. During the months of February and July we host a large amount of School and Nursery visits. During their time with us they do a variety of activities including animals handling, talks, feeding and tractor rides etc.

As a School Visits Team member you would be trained in all areas and would be confident in talking to children, attaining their attention and delivering fun, informative and educational sessions.

As the Farm can get very busy during these times the quality of customer service, attention to detail and ensuring the health, hygiene and cleanliness at the farm is paramount. Our staff are required to be energetic, enthusiastic, responsible, trustworthy, hardworking and reliable.

Responsibilities include:

- Meeting coaches at the gate and ensuring they park correctly
- Giving a Health and Safety talk to all children, teachers and helpers
- Learning and giving interactive educational talks on various animals
- Running sessions in the Animal Handling area with small animals
- Running Pig and Duck feeding sessions
- Providing tractor rides
- Ensuring the safety of groups at all time

Experience & Qualifications

- Confidence handling animals is essential
- Experience and confidence working with children is desirable but not essential
- A first aid qualification is desirable
- Driving licence essential

Working hours and rate of pay
